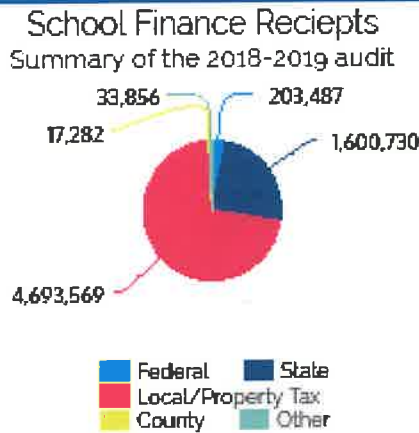

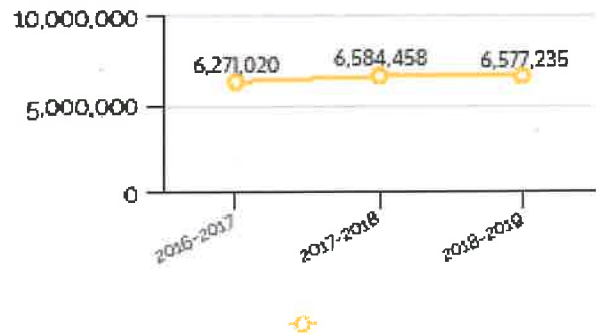

2018-2019 Annual Report

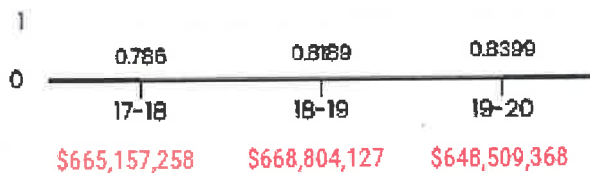

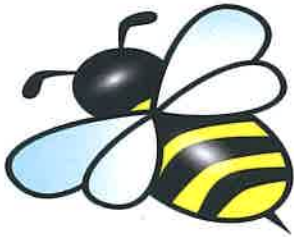
