Hopefully the staff and kids can forgive me some day. It was a miserable time.

Activities—who gets to go and how many? DHM is at 75% or is it at 25%? We made it through the fall pretty unscathed. We have lost a couple activities this winter due to complications at the opponent's school. It is a real struggle.

This has been a long semester. Everyone is weary. Pandemic fatigue is real. I hope that the couple extra days of break allows you and your family time to reflect and realize that we are going to survive this.

If you do not think it will happen, we can give you instances of schools cancelling events because the opponents district were not willing to follow guidelines.

We have lost two activities to COVID. We do not want to lose anymore because we as a district are not willing to follow protocol at this time.

The NSAA has made it very clear on what they expect us to do.
