We are nearing the end of Quarter 3 for this school year. Winter sports have finished, spring sports are starting, and nice weather is just around the corner. This time of year can be a challenge for both students and faculty with the crazy weather that we often experience. It is essential that we have continued communication with the patrons of our district regarding student absences.

Compulsory attendance laws require that students have to be in school. Students that are absent more than 20 cumulative days during the school year will be reported to the county attorney. It is important for parents to contact the school as soon as possible when a student has to be absent. We do not expect you to bring your sick child to school, but we do want to know they will be absent. Doctor approved absences do not count towards compulsory attendance. So when possible, bring a note from the doctor to get the absences excused.

Students will be starting to look at scheduling for next year during March. Parents be on the lookout for registration forms for classes next year. 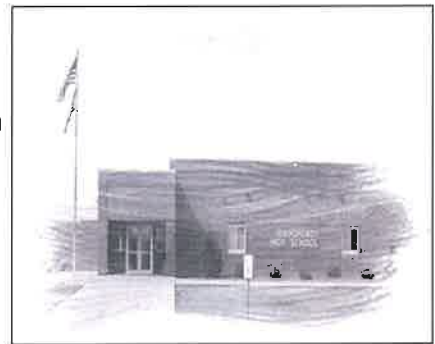
