Reading Awards- Grades 7-9

Research indicates a good way to increase student achievement is to encourage reading. If a child reads as much as one million words per year, they will be in the top 2% of students nationwide. The Accelerated Reading Program, AR, makes it possible to record how many words a student has read and the points they earned for tests they have taken. This word count and points earned goes beyond the textbooks, articles, and assignments read in class. The awards for reading are for the free-choice reading books that the students read during Silent Sustained Reading time and in their own free time.

The following awards are given for the number of words they have read and for achievement in attaining point goals set by each student.
