- There will not be school on September 6.

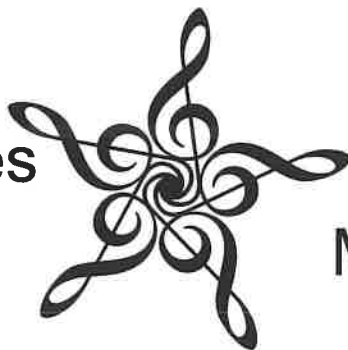
At the beginning of September the students will be taking their NWEA MAP Growth tests. We use these tests to measure progress and to help guide our instruction.
