Do you have a balance between your work and leisure time? Do you enjoy new responsibilities and look forward to achieving better results? Your attitudes about your work can greatly affect your job performance and interactions with coworkers. Striving toward occupational wellness will help to give you personal satisfaction and allow you to find enrichment in our life through work. 5—Social—How satisfying are your relationships with your spouse, your family, your friends, and associates? 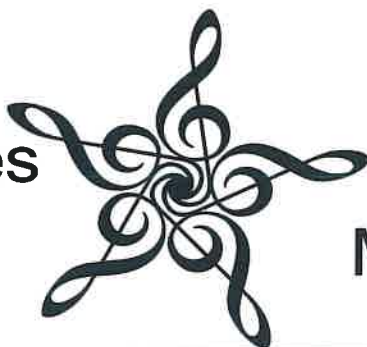

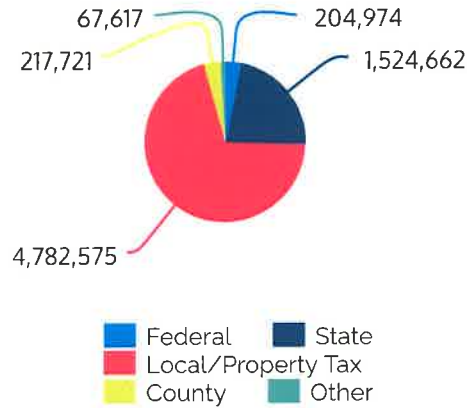

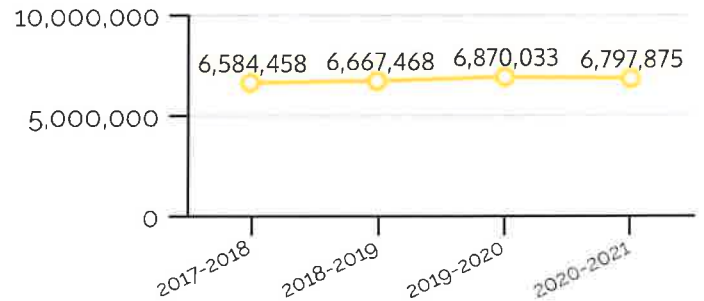
2020-2021 Annual Report

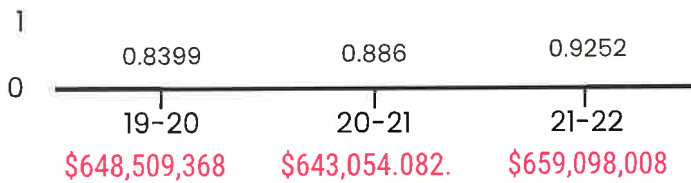
School Finance Receipts Summary of the 2020-2021 audit



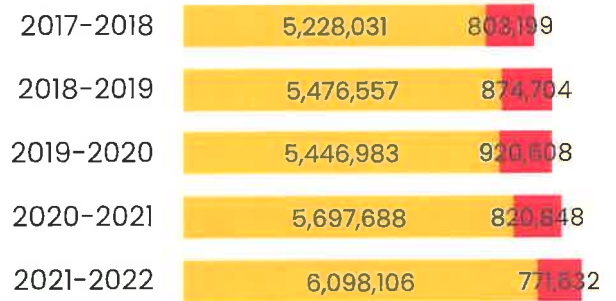
Total General Fund Disbursements

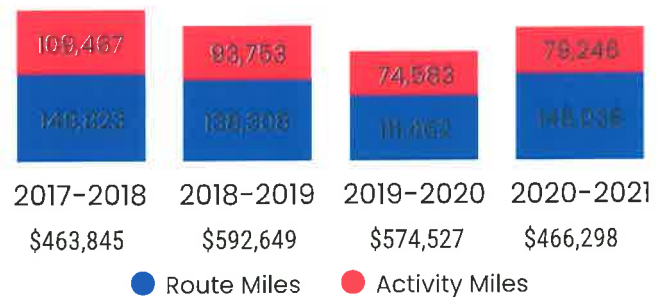

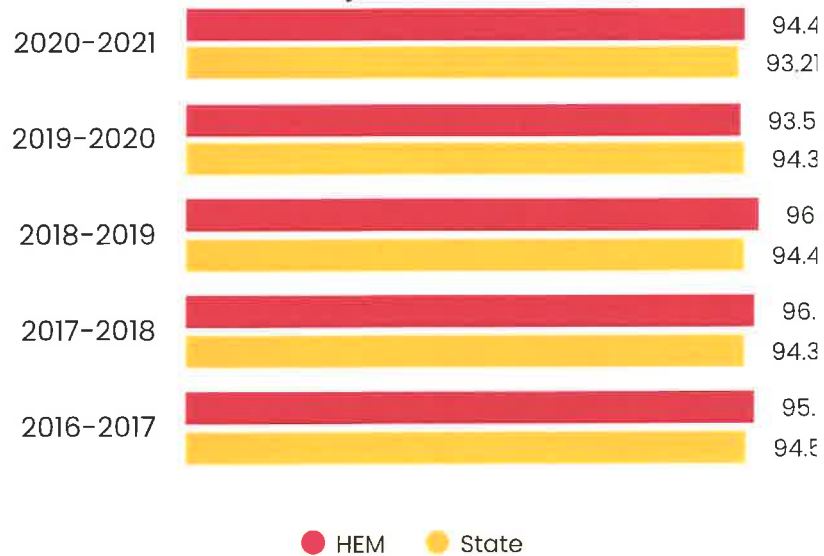

PK-12 Daily Attendance Data



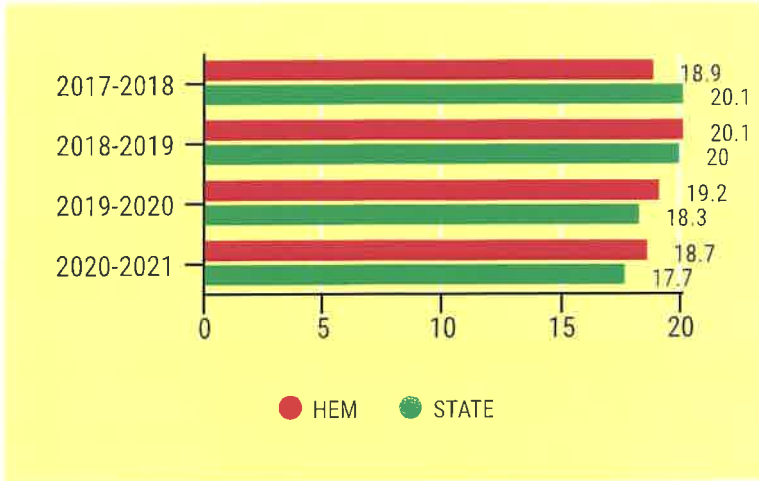
District Geography

District 10 is made up of land that sits in three counties-Box Butte, Sheridan and Dawes. There are 1,177 square miles.

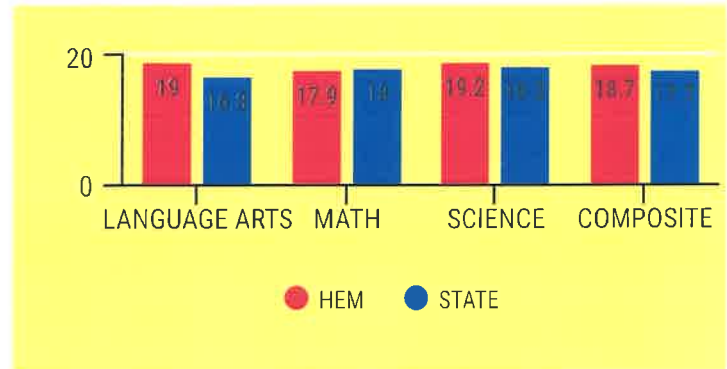
School Board

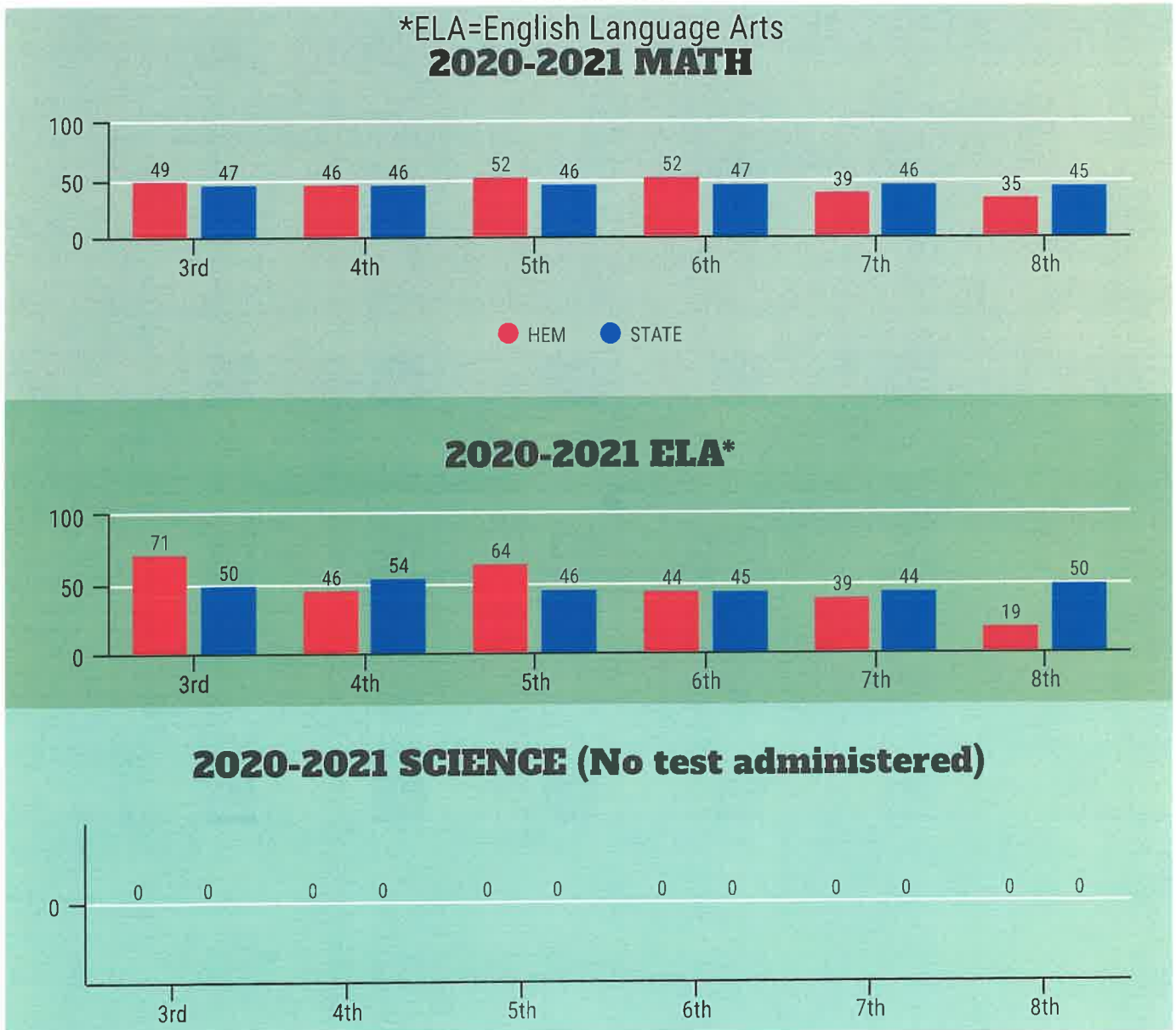


**2020-2021
