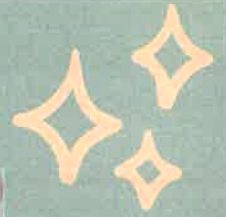

# COUNSELING NEWSLETTER



Hello Bobcat Nation -- I feel like with the Holidays taking place and winter break coming up, I wanted to share a few thoughts. Sometimes as parents we want to get things "just right", which causes chaos and stress. Here are some tips, courtesy of *Institute of Child Psychology*.

## 1 Only Paying Attention to the Wrongdoings



Children need their connection. If the only time they get this is when they're doing something you don't like, such as acting out, the behaviour may continue. To the child that may feel like the only way for their emotional needs to be met.

### *Try this instead*

Catch your child being good—focus on the behavior you want to see. Give them some one-on-one time each week.

## 3 Taking Charge of THEIR Homework

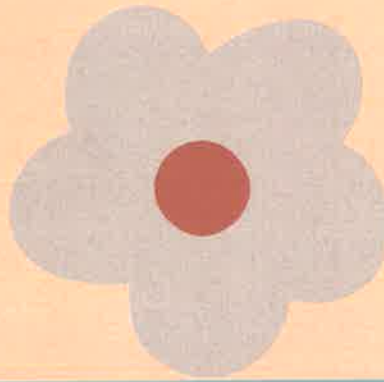


The message sent is that they are not capable. Children need to learn to take responsibility for their own lives - **it is their homework not yours.**

### *Try this instead*

Let your children know that their homework is their responsibility, not yours. You're available to help (set up a time), but if they don't do it, they will have to answer to their teacher.

## 5 Skipping Self-Care for Themselves!



We cannot fill from an empty cup. Your happiness is just as important as your child's. And if your cup is empty, you are more likely to be reactive or absent. With a full cup themselves, parents engage more and create stronger connections with their children.

### *Try this instead*

Take time for you. Rest. Heal. HAVE FUN (away from your kids). You are worth the investment for your child's well-being.

## 2 Immediately Reacting When Upset

In stressful times, you are more likely to lash out, scream, and create unrealistic consequences.

### *Try this instead*

It is best to wait until you are calm, to give logical consequences or to teach them a new skill (as discipline means teach, not punish). You can still set a limit & keep your child safe, but we don't teach our child to swim when we both are drowning.

## 4 Being Too Permissive



Our responsibility is to be a leader for our children. When we give in, don't set limits for them, or can't sit with their feelings - it says we aren't strong enough to take care of them.

Children need to have routine, authority, and someone who can handle their feelings.

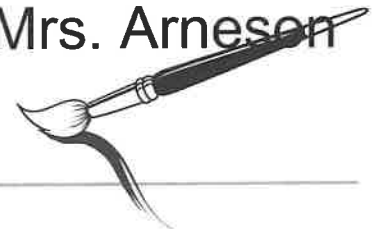

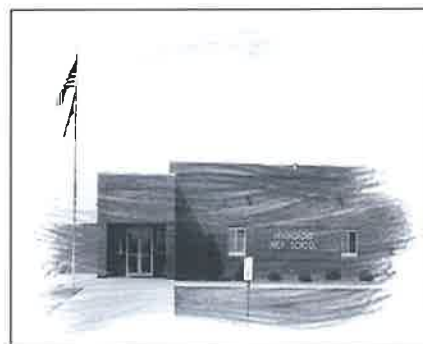
